Transitions

We are rapidly approaching the end of the year and 'transition' time.

Year 6 will be attending their new schools for induction and taster days and all the other children are beginning to think about their next year in school. Parents of our new arrivals in **Foundation Stage 2** have been invited to their induction meeting on **4th July**. If you are attending this meeting please make sure that you have child care arranged for this event as it is an adults-only meeting, where we will be sharing with you lots of information about starting at Brompton-Westbrook.

As you know, at Brompton-Westbrook school we deal with transitions very well – we have to with approximately **45%** mobility each year! Information sharing is the key to this and class teachers have already been thinking about what information they need to pass onto the new class teacher to ensure that all children settle in quickly and 'hit the ground running' when they move up to their new year group. We also plan activities to ensure that every child can meet their new teacher and visit their new classroom before they start in September. Some children will have special induction plans to make sure that they feel really confident about their transition.

Due to our high pupil turnover we do not finalise class lists until as late as possible in the year, but if you wish to speak to your current class teacher about this please do not hesitate to do so via the normal methods (at the door at the end of the day, make an appointment via the office or email the office for an appointment time.)

Children will be told who their new class teacher is via their end of year reports which will be sent home towards the end of term. We will text you on the day they are due home so that they don't get lost in book bags etc!
