Step 2

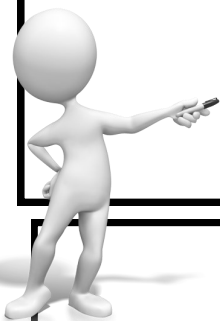
Try and work out carefully what you are going to say. You could write a few notes on a piece of paper to help you. It is a good idea to write the order that you are going to talk about things.

Step 4

You will be talking/ presenting in front of the class. Practise at home first. Don't worry about talking in front of everyone—this is something that you want to share with everyone else—you are the expert in what you are presenting.
